## Facts about Regensburg


- at the northernmost point of the Danube between the landscapes of the Franconian Jura, the Bavarian Forest and Gäuboden
- 60 minutes driving time to the international airports MUC and NUE
- since 2004 among Germany's TOP 12 regions with excellent prospects for the future (Prognos Zukunftsatlas)
- approximately 170,000 inhabitants
- catchment area: approximately
   700,000 people
- prime business location with leading international high-tech-enterprises and strong medium-sized companies
- second-highest employment density among Germany's metropolitan areas
- unemployment rate below the Bavarian and German average
- 90,735 Euro gross domestic product per inhabitant (in comparison 46,698 Euro GDP per inhabitant in Bavaria)
